



Train and Engine Service

Position Summary:

Engineers and Conductors are responsible for the safe and efficient movement of freight trains, placing rail cars to facilitate loading and unloading, and makeup/breakdown trains in a rail yard, customer facility or similar locations.

General duties include:

- Review instructions from dispatchers and other train crew members
- Receive and transmit information by radio and telephone
- Assist and instruct train crews to couple and uncouple cars, operate switches, and make minor repairs to railcars
- Work with customer service to ensure accurate movement and placement of cars
- Maintain awareness of surrounding area and suspicious activity to ensure rail safety
- Observe, interpret, and relay signals and other indications affecting movement of trains
- Make adjustments with moving and positioning of rail equipment
- Maintain a professional demeanor and positive attitude while interacting with coworkers and customers

Job requirements:

- 18 years of age or older
- High School Diploma or GED
- Must possess a valid driver's license
- Ability to work from written and verbal instructions
- Must be able to work with a team, take direction from supervisors, adhere to work schedules, focus attention on details, and follow work rules
- Must be able to work varying hours, including weekends and overtime as required
- Must be able to occasionally work in varying weather conditions
- Must be able to submit to and be able to pass a drug screen
- Maintain a good attendance record
- Must be able to pass a background check
- Must be willing to wear required personal protective equipment

Physical requirements:

- Must be able to stand and walk on uneven surfaces for extended periods of time
- Must be able to carry and lift 30 lbs. frequently and push and pull 75 lbs. frequently
- Must be able to carry and lift occasionally 50-90 lbs., push and pull 250 lbs. and grip 100 lbs.

Rate of pay:

- \$24.00 to \$27.00 depending on experience and relevant qualifications
